The temperatures are cooling, the sweaters are coming out, the leaves are changing colors; unless you live in Hawaii, of course. The foster home which we leased is continuing to host people in God's love. The boy we fostered is now with a family member, but there is a possibility that he will move back in our home, depending on his family circumstances. From March till May, we housed a young injured man who was in need of care till he recovered and was able to move in his own apartment. In June, we temporarily hosted a medical student who is currently completing his residency in Honolulu. On July 14, there was a fire in a large condominium building in Honolulu that resulted in the death of three people. We hosted a young couple and their little baby that lived in that building because they lost their home and all their belongings in the fire. Currently, our home is hosting a young man who is studying and helping with the Hawaiian Mission. Through God's grace, the home has been a blessing and has given rest to several people; may God continue to be glorified through this home, which we could not have without your prayers and support.

We are excited to announce that The Hawaiian Mission is undergoing projects that will help expand our mission; this will result in more lives being positively affected, through God's grace. We are continuing to work and build our relationships here on Oahu, while expanding the Mission on other islands. One of our next projects, is to purchase an ambulance and convert it to a mobile mission center. We will go to several areas on the island and tend to the needs of our precious people, including young children, who are houseless.
